Three Months of Grace Bible Reading

December **The God of Grace**

Week 1: Genesis 6:1-22 records the downward spiral of sinful men, and it is in that desperate situation that the Bible first uses the Hebrew word often translated “grace.” In this passage, it’s translated “favor.”

Week 2: Psalm 84:1-12 is a psalm extolling the joys of worshipping God in ways that please Him, and in verse 11 we learn that it is the Lord who gives grace.

Week 3: In the first half of **Genesis 18:1-33** we learn of God’s grace to Abraham and Sarah. As impossible as the situation may seem, God always gives us everything we need to fulfill His will. And the second half shows God’s willingness to pour favor on the most undeserving.

Week 4: Hebrews 4:1-16 describes the glorious future rest of God’s people and reminds us that we can have confidence approaching the throne of Grace.

Week 5: John 1:1-51 is the revelation of Jesus, the Son of the Father, full of grace and truth.

January **Our Gracious Salvation**

Week 6: Among other things **John 15:1-7** reveals the grace of God to graft us into Himself, but at the end of the chapter we learn about the grace of God that shows us our desperate need for Him.

Week 7: Ephesians 2:1-22 teaches about our new life in Christ and how it can only ever come through the grace of God.

Week 8: II Corinthians 3:1-18 expounds on the New Covenant by comparing it to the Old Covenant by which we learn about the grace of God that transforms us into the image of Christ from one degree of glory to another.

Week 9: Titus 2:1-15 explains the duties of God’s people, but it’s only possible for us to be holy as God is holy because of the grace He provides.

Week 10: II Corinthians 5:1-20 uses our future glorification as one of the motivations for the joyous privilege we have to be God’s Ambassadors on this earth.

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February God's Grace in Us

Week 11: Proverbs 1:1-33 reveals the blessings of wisdom, among which is the reality that is like a graceful wreath on our heads.

Week 12: In II Corinthians 12:1-21 we learn through Paul's personal experience how God's grace is sufficient for us.

Week 13: II Timothy 2:1-26 teaches what the life of those who are strong in the grace that is in Jesus Christ looks like.

Week 14: II Corinthians 9:1-15 exemplifies the gracious of God at work in us as we submit to the grace of God that abounds to us for every good deed.

Week 15: Psalm 37:1-40 contrasts the wicked who take what they want with the righteous who is gracious and gives.
